

MINUTES OF THE 27TH ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING OF THE INSTITUTE OF SOUND, COMMUNICATIONS AND VISUAL ENGINEERS LIMITED HELD ON TUESDAY, 19 MARCH 2024 at Coombe Abbey, Binley, Leicestershire

The President, Neil Voce MInstSCVE, declared the meeting open at 2.15pm and welcomed all members in attendance.

24.01 Apologies for absence

Apologies were received from 6 members.

24.02 Minutes of the 26th AGM

The minutes of the 2023 AGM held on 22 March 2023, were pre-circulated and were proposed by Gareth Collyer AMInstSCVE, seconded by Helen Goddard FInstSCVE and approved by all members in attendance.

24.03 Annual Report by President

Neil Voce MInstSCVE, outlined some of the key activities of the Institute over the past year;

Increased membership and upgrades

Membership had increased from 1005 to 1126 in the last year. We have 63 Supporting Members and 17 Premium Supporting Members. We have received a number of applications from our members for upgradies. We urge members to apply for upgrades as and when they gain further experience and technical knowledge within the industry.

• Lifetime service membership

The free lifetime membership scheme for members who have served over 21 years service and are over the age of 66 years, has been well received. This is the second year of implementation.

Membership demographic

There is continued increases in the 20yrs+ and 30yrs+ age range of new members. Members from the AV market sector had grown significantly. Other members work within the PA. VA, ALS, CCTV and Acoustics sectors.

ISCVE training

A significant number of training courses have taken place throughout the year and we continue to finalise courses for AV and Microphone Users training ready to launch later in the year.

ECS Card Scheme

There had been a small increase with effect 1 March 2024 from JIB/ECS for assessments and cards. The scheme continues to be successful for the Institute.

Recurring membership fees

The facility to make recurring payments with credit cards for membership fee renewals has been set up in the membership portal. All members are encouraged to use this method of payment to avoid additional administration costs with chasing outstanding fees
