

Lobbying Committee – Function

The Lobbying Committee is a sub committee of the ISCVE Council and is made up of ISCVE members who have been endorsed by ISCVE Council. It shall consist of a Chairman and committee members.

The Lobbying Committee shall be responsible to Council, and the Chair shall prepare periodic reports to Council of the committee's plans and actions.

The Lobbying Committee is responsible for:

Lobbying on behalf of the ISCVE Membership, under guidance of Council for:

- a) Betterment of the industry of Sound, Communications and Visual Engineers
- b) improvements in public or employee safety where ISCVE Members and their companies can so contribute
- c) increased recognition of the ISCVE and the role of its members in the regulated areas of safety and training
- d) to increase the level of opportunity given to the Members because of their affiliation with the ISCVE.

The lobbying committee shall seek the guidance of Council on any issues it considers might be controversial.
